Voter Registration

The first thing you need to do is to register to vote in the district. If you are not already registered to vote, you may register in person at the following locations. You may also <u>register to vote</u> at the county building October 10^{th} – October 19^{th} and <u>register</u> during the grace period on the Early Voting dates (October 22^{nd} – November 3^{rd}) at any of the 16 voting sites. Lastly, you may <u>register to vote</u> by mail by submitting the IL Voter form in person or by mail to : Carla Wyckoff, Lake County Clerk, 18 County Street, Room 101, Waukegan, IL 60085. It must be postmarked no later than 28 days before the election. Vote by Mail

If you will not be in the area to vote on November 6th or you wish to save a trip to the polls, you may request a ballot by mail through November 1^{st} . The voting ballot must be postmarked before the election, by November 5^{th} .

Early Voting

As was the case in previous years, <u>early voting</u> will be conducted for the November 6th election, as well. <u>Early voting</u> will take place between October 22 and November 3rd. You may <u>vote</u> at any of the 16 Lake County voting sites during the early voting window, please visit <u>http://www.lakecountyil.gov/332/Voter-Services</u> to find the applicable times for the site that you wish to visit.
